REGULATIONS & RELEASE FORM

Verification of vaccinations for RABIES is required: no dog may participate in any training class or be present on the business premises without such verification. The BORDETELLA vaccination guards your dog against the more severe, air-borne forms of Kennel Cough. In order for the vaccination to be in effect fully, your dog should have it a minimum of 72 hours prior to coming to class. Dogs most susceptible to kennel cough are young pups and older dogs, both groups that tend to have a weaker immune system. Remember that even though your dog is vaccinated, it may still contract one of the lesser life-threatening types, much like our common cold. We highly recommend that you protect your dog with this vaccination and others recommended by your veterinarian.

For Starters agility classes and higher, all dogs must be twelve (12) months of age or older and be under reasonable control of the owner. Off-leash recall control amidst distractions as well as prior obedience training is required; however, the possibility to test out of this requirement is available. Female dogs "in season" are prohibited from attending class. HOWEVER, handlers should attend classes without the dog during this time and continue to work with the dog at home.

The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for the behavior of the dog at all times and as such must be aware of what the dog is doing at all times. Any altercations (dog/dog or dog/person) resulting in any injury requiring veterinarian or physician attention and or costs, will be the sole responsibility of the owner/handler of the dog causing the altercation.

No person and/or dog enrolled in the any class(es) at Arrowhead Dog Training Academy will be allowed in the training arenas, or on the agility equipment whether indoors or out, at any time other than class time, without the expressed consent of the Instructor and/or owner(s) and will be doing so at their own risk. Attended open building hours will be available during each month to allow for practice either for obedience or agility. Dates and hours can be viewed on the calendar on the ADTA website.

If, while attending classes, a dog is deemed to be uncontrollable and/or aggressive as to create a general disturbance or pose a threat to any other class attendees (human or canine), it will be required to discontinue group sessions immediately. This decision will be made solely by the ADTA Instructor and/or Owner(s) who shall have total authority in the disciplining of an aggressive dog if he/she determines that another dog or person may be in jeopardy. The Instructor will also have complete authority in determining the extent to which he/she will permit an unruly dog and/or person to remain in class. If any dog is excused from the group sessions, the remainder of the class fee, less a \$5.00 processing fee, will be refunded OR the balance may be used toward an obedience class, behavioral consultation or private lessons.

Cancellation of class registration and application for refund can be made no later than the day before the first class day of the session listed on the front of this form. No refund of class fees will be made once the session begins except in instances as stated above or in the case of a medical dilemma prohibiting you or your dog from further attendance. This must be supported by a written statement from your physician or veterinarian.

In consideration of the acceptance of registration for class training, I hereby agree to hold the Arrowhead Dog Training Academy, its instructors holding classes, and all persons connected with or associated with said Academy, in whatever capacity, harmless from:

- 1) *Any loss or injury which may occur to any person and/or thing which may be caused directly or indirectly to any person and/or thing by any biting by or to, or any other act of the said dog or dogs while in or upon the premises or grounds, or in, at or near any entrances or exits thereto, whether or not and when the said dog or dogs is or are being delivered or removed or otherwise handled, and personally to assume full responsibility and liability therefore, and:*
- 2) *The disappearance and/or loss by theft or otherwise, and/or death of said dog named, and/or all injury or injuries, and/or damage or damages which may occur or be caused by the negligence or carelessness of said Academy, its members or any person(s) connected with the said Academy in any manner whatsoever, or by any other person(s) and/or by any other cause(s) directly or indirectly operating while such person(s) and/or dog(s) is/are on the training premises.*

AGILITY

STARTERS

The Starters class lays the foundation for the obstacles used in the sport of agility as well as giving the handler and dog a great start on building a strong working relationship utilizing focus techniques and positive reinforcement. This class is for dogs that have never been exposed to agility equipment and also for those dogs that have had any type of set-back concerning agility equipment. It gives the dogs all the basic building blocks to feel confident learning to conquer the obstacles in a safe and fun manner, while allowing the dogs to learn confidence and self-reliance. Dogs must be a minimum of one year of age to enter into this class.

10-Week Course \$100.00

INTERMEDIATE

The Intermediate class begins concentrating on teaching and improving upon the handling skills of the human component of the agility team. During this class, the dogs will continue to gain confidence on the agility equipment while we begin to make use of different handling methods to improve your ability to give your dog direction and support on the agility course. The prerequisite for this class is the successful completion of the Starters class.

10-Week Course \$100.00

ADVANCED

This class further develops you and your dog's agility education with a strong emphasis on building motivation and independent performance of the obstacles. It is also designed to increase your dog's responses to your body language and voice commands, while reinforcing proper execution of obstacles, solid stays and objective thinking. The prerequisite for this class is the successful completion of the Intermediate class and /or trialing at the lower levels of competition.

10-Week Course \$100.00

MASTERS

This class is specifically for those teams that are currently trialing and will focus on dealing with more difficult handling situations and coursework. Courses that are seen/run at trials should be brought to class for evaluation and/or set-up for instruction. The prerequisite for this class is the successful completion of the Advanced class and /or trialing at the higher levels of competition.

10-Week Course \$100.00
